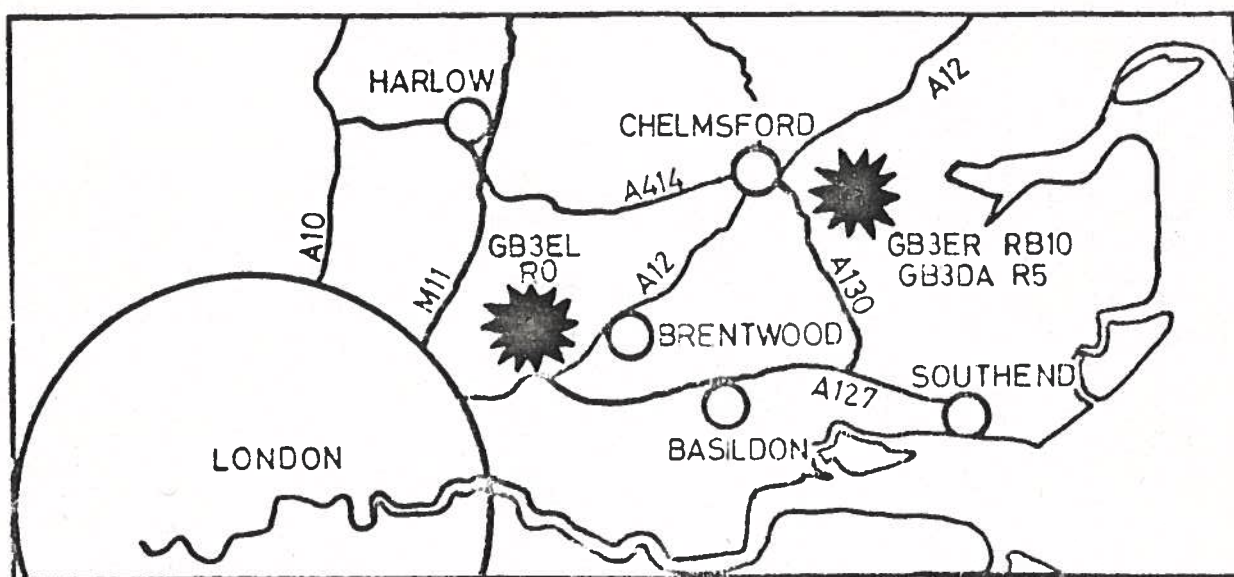


Getting repeaters on the air, and keeping them running, requires a combination of skills ranging from logic and RF circuitry design/construction, to metal-work and aerial rigging. If you are interested in building and running 'boxes', or if you use the Essex repeaters, you are most welcome to join the Group.



GB3DA - This VHF repeater is co-sited with GB3ER at Danbury, and operates on channel R5 (145.125 MHz input, 145.725 MHz output); it came into operation on 2nd October 1980. The control circuitry is of special interest: all access-logic, callsigns etc. are driven by an 8048 micro-processor. GB3DA's coverage (to mobiles) extends as far as North Kent, Brentwood, Harlow and Colchester.
