2 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS AGM

3 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

First of all I would like to thank Graham G7JYBD who is stepping down from the committee this year. He has always been helpful and will be missed *- applause*

This time last year we had a huge amount of work going on changing sites as well as running DA/ER and DB. The latter has seen additional earthling for lighting protection being added this year.

This year we have been able to complete the re-siting of MB7IDA and GB7ZP. Both are back on air and as the accounts show, it has cost us in antennas and controllers. As these are both digitally linked systems it has caused us quite a few challenges on networking which aren't yet over. More work on this is in prospect in the coming year, but at least we can do that at a more leisurely pace.

I won't make this speech too long as quite a few of the updates and highlights of the year are in the slide presentation that Murray has.

Whilst we have had some highlights I must say it was rather sad to be at the last event at W&S at Hockley. Over the years they have been incredibly helpful to the repeater group. Having no local emporium in Essex will be quite a loss even though their business is continuing down south

Consequently, I would like to give a special thanks to Joel, who with fewer rally events, has still managed to catch quite a few people for membership subs, renewals and donations.

Everybody on the committee has again worked hard giving up their free time to keep the repeaters going and I would like to thank all committee members for their hard work.

4 HONORARY SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Honorary Secretary gave the following report to those present:

Good evening and Thank you. Many thanks for attending and supporting the group

I think it fair to say we are in a better place now than two years ago when we had the sudden loss of Clive G1EUC.

In my own case apart from secretarial work I get involved with the IT/networking of our digital systems GB7ZP for D-Star and MB7IDA for Echolink.

During the earlier part of the year we got ZP onto its long-term X-300 antenna and switched on MB7IDA. I have a few slides with updates which include that, which you might like to see... (see annex)

The pair has taught us quite a bit on remote control, network issues etc. We have recently been fortunate to add a high capacity UPS to the controllers and are close to introducing a complete new gateway for GB7ZP. It has been interesting to see that ironically since the demise of GB7SS in Hockley, D-Star activity has grown and is more popular than ever. Our new G3 Gateway should enable more fun and flexibility as it accommodates some additional modes if you have the newer radios. Meanwhile we hope to learn from the difficult experience that Joel has on had MB6CE which has gone from D-Star only to multimode during the year (DMR, D-Star and Fusion)

At a more basic level this year saw the NoVs on the four repeaters and the beacon being renewed for another three years and a refresh of our guides/PR has got underway.

The loss of the W&S in Hockley and their Open Days has been unfortunate. So following tonight we are fairly sure that the next event will be the 33rd Canvey Rally on Sunday 4th February and will again participate in the CARS Table Top sale in the summer. I will also be at the Xmas dinner that John G1JIJ has in hand too. We do of course keep an eye on other opportunities too

Finally I would just like to wish Graham G7JYD well. Repeater work is not all technical – Kristian & Graham had the garden spades out laying extra earth wiring for GB3DB lightning protection!
