2 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS AGM

Acceptance of the draft 2019 AGM minutes (the last previous meeting due to Covid) was proposed and were approved for placement on the ERG website

3 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT by David M1DOZ

Good evening Hams and Friends of Hams

This is only my second Chair's report in four years and hopefully Covid is behind us. Certainly, before Covid nobody had ever heard of Zoom calls and Webinars.

Some of you will recall we had problems with our two older Tait-based versions of GB3DA which were unreliable and prone to breakdown.

We have not disposed of these two older units – they have been repaired by Ed Payne G6HNW (thank you Ed), so we now have spare units for both DA and ER.

Because GB3DA and GB3ER were very old and unreliable, we made the decision to firstly replace GB3DA, and then GB3ER, with modern and reliable equipment.

Yaesu had upgraded their 'Repeater in a box' to DR-2, so we made the decision to first purchase one DR-2XE Fusion Repeater, and this was put into service in early 2020. Touch wood the new DA unit has been reasonably stable (even though it does not have a K). Once the new GB3DA unit had been tested for a few weeks, we then felt it necessary to also upgrade GB3ER with the purchase of a second DR-2XE unit. This unit is now in place, and we also have back-up units for GB3DA and GB3ER. *Photo of DA+ER – Apr-2022 >>*



Whilst both units offer Fusion or C4FM, as well as analogue capabilities, we feel that GB3DA should not be linked or offer Fusion at this time. GB3DA is used by many clubs most days of the week for club nets and has the full coverage of almost all of Essex and parts of North Kent.

We see no reason to change something that is working well for all. We originally had planned to make GB3ER a complete Fusion/C4FM repeater with connections to servers round the world. In order to link GB3ER we need Internet at the Danbury location. We have looked at various phone company packages and none are particularly cheap (and many do not offer a fixed IP address) and then the question is 'would GB3ER get used (anymore) if we had it linked worldwide, using a wires X Box on Fusion? And then the question is – would members then be willing to pay an extra contribution towards the cost of a phone line being installed at Danbury??

There are a few members that may utilise GB3ER more if GB3ER was linked round the world, but I suspect most would not; an example of usage vs need is the 6-metre repeater which has been operational at Bobs house for many years, and I suspect 90% of the membership have never even opened the 6-metre repeater. Whist DA and ER are both working reasonably well, we still want to upgrade the old coax tails / patch leads that have been in place for more than 25 years.

The committee as you know does need help and we certainly need a person with technical expertise and some fresh ideas. We also need to increase membership so that we can offer a better service – we are seeking volunteers who might host an operating repeater at their home.

Can the ERG members let the committee know as to what equipment we should consider operating in the future? It just leaves me to say a very big thankyou to the current committee for this year's hard work
